### **Student Requirements for \$1,000 GFAI Renewable Scholarship**

- Have previously received a GFAI Scholarship and successfully completed those requirements
- Are an undergraduate college sophomore or junior at the time of application
- Want to work in the grain handling and feed industries
- Students will be required to complete one of the following (choose one):
  - o Interview a manager or an employee in a supervisory role who holds a career in the grain and feed industry and write a story to be published by GFAI on the Scholarship Blog
  - o Submit a 30-60 second video with subject matter that involves the grain handling and feed industries
  - o Work or job shadow 2 days at a member facility and write a blog post about the experience (an internship may qualify). Member facilities must be approved by GFAI staff prior to submitting the blog.
